(iv)

objectives which are aligned with the overall goal of the consortium. The Consortium will nominate a reputable Lead (Coordinator) who has strong track record in research.

3.0 Funding for Research Consortium

(i) Each consortium member is responsible to source for research funding and support themselves financially either from internal or external grants.

(ii) For the consortium member affiliated with UCSI University, CERVIE may assist in providing the information to source for an external grant to achieve the sustainability of the research projects.

(iii) The research consortium shall jointly apply for funding to support the research activities.

4.0 Consortium Activities

(i) The University expects the highest standards of good scientific practice in conducting research within all research fields. The consortium research activities must comply to the university policies, rules and regulations.

(ii) The consortium member affiliated with UCSI University must demonstrate excellent performance according to the Key Performance Index (KPI) developed with input from their members. The performance is evaluated based on the research outputs* of the consortium and will be assessed by a Research Consortium Evaluation Committee comprising at least FOUR (4) P 1 49 Geartis(a)(ssar)-5sormt(ed)(n)-(cn)11()-(e)-12(e)
